

# Student Portion Under the HEERF III (American Rescue Plan)

## Quarterly Fund Report (Information as of September 30, 2021)

**(1) An acknowledgement that the institution signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution has used the applicable amount of funds designated under the ARP (a)(1) program to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.**

Institutions who received HEERF I grant funds under the CARES Act were not required to submit an application for the HEERF II or HEERF III grant. Wentworth Institute of Technology (the "University") (received its HEERF III Grant Award Notification on May 20, 2021). Wentworth Institute of Technology will use no less than \$4,812,271 (the student portion) of the funds received under Section 2003(a)(1) of the Act CFDA 84.425E Allocation to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.

**(2) The total amount of funds that the institution will receive or has received from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.**

The total amount of funds that Wentworth Institute of Technology received from the Department is \$4,812,271 pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement [for] Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.

**(3) The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under the ARP (a)(1) as of the date of submission (i.e., as of the initial report and every calendar quarter thereafter).**

The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants that have been distributed to students under Section 2003(a)(1) of the ARP Act as of the initial report dated June 19, 2021, is \$0 and is \$0 for the calendar quarters covering up to September 30, 2021. The University plans to begin awarding ARP HEERF III Act student grants in the Fall 2021 semester.

**(4) The estimated total number of students at the institution that are eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the ARP (a)(1) program.**

The estimated total amount of students that are eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid has yet to be determined. The University plans to begin awarding ARP HEERF III Act student grants in the Fall 2021 semester and the number of students eligible will be determined at that time.

**(5) The total number of students who have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant under the ARP (a)(1) program.**

The University plans to begin awarding ARP HEERF III Act student grants in the Fall 2021 semester. The total number of students who have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant under Section 2003(a)(1) of the ARP Act at the University is \$0 as of September 30, 2021.

**(6) The method(s) used by the institution to determine which students receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants and how much they would receive under the ARP (a)(1) program.**

The University plans to begin awarding ARP HEERF III Act grants to students beginning with the Fall 2021 semester and is currently evaluating the best method for determining eligibility and distributing ARP HEERF III Act student grants.

**(7) Any instructions, directions, or guidance provided by the institution to students concerning the Emergency Financial Aid Grants.**

As of June 30, 2021, the University conducted a direct outreach to financial aid applicants about the opportunity to receive a financial aid adjustment, as described in Section 479A of the HEA.
