Women at Wentworth: Wentworth has introduced a new women's undergraduate Certificate in Women's Leadership. The Women at Wentworth (W@W) UG program offers students a customized pathway to develop leadership skills, build networks, and cultivate tenacity for a lifetime of success. Students earn micro credential badges for activities they complete each year which lead to the certificate of completion. W@W UG is designed to recognize the many leadership related activities they already do while offering opportunities to attend additional leadership programing.

Resources and Reminders



<u>Discounted MBTA Semester Pass</u>: MBTA commuter passes for the spring semester will be on sale from November 1st until December 8th. These passes offer a 15% savings for students who commute to and from campus at least four days a week. Additional financial assistance is available for qualified students.

<u>FAFSA</u>: The 2023-2024 FAFSA is now available. This application is for the academic year beginning Fall 2023. But it's never too early to apply! The FAFSA Simplification Act will reduce the number of questions from 108 to 36!

Spring 2023 Housing Information: Information regarding Spring 2023 housing opportunities has been released via Wentworth email. Students who currently do not live on campus and wish to for this upcoming semester should review this information and complete their housing agreement and submit their \$500 housing down-payment prior to the November 30th deadline.

Spring Semester Bill: The spring 2023 semester bill is now available on Leopardweb and is due December 1. Students' accounts must be paid in full, on an approved payment plan, or covered by pending financial aid by December 1 to avoid late payment fees and holds that prevent registration, add/drop, and move into campus housing. Families can enroll in a four month payment plan through November 29.
