New Women's Track Teams: Wentworth will be adding Women's Indoor and Outdoor Track as new varsity sports teams, increasing our total number of varsity teams to 19.

Updates from Student Accounts

Fall 2024 Semester Bill: The fall semester E-Bill will be available through myWentworth on June 15 by clicking the Student Accounts tile. The bill, along with the health insurance waiver or enrollment, will be due on August 1.

Outside Funding Sources: It is important to complete necessary items such as submitting scholarship confirmation letters, third party payer and VA documentation, completing the Federal Direct Stafford loans Master Promissory Note (MPN) and Loan Entrance Counseling requirements, applying for a parent PLUS or alternative loan and requesting college savings plan funds, by July 1. This will ensure that the student's fall semester charges are covered by the August 1 due date.

Updated E-Bill and Payment Plan Portal: The Student Accounts Office will soon launch a new E-Bill and payment plan through Flywire! Through our new portal, students and bill payers can easily enroll in a payment plan, make a payment, set up an authorized user, print an account statement, and view student account activity. Details of this exciting new partnership will be sent

to all students' Wentworth emails in the next few weeks.
