

What courses are HSS electives?



Any course that is considered a humanities or social science course at WIT counts for the HSS elective requirement. These include **all** courses in the following subjects:

Social Sciences Subjects:

- Communications (COMM)
- Economics (ECON)
- Political Science (POLS)
- Psychology (PSYCH)
- Sociology (SOCL)

Humanities Subjects:

- Humanities (HUMN)
- Literature (LITR)
- History (HIST)
- Philosophy (PHIL)

Note: Some courses count as credit for social sciences **or** humanities. These courses have the following subjects:

- HUSS
- HSSI
- CSAS

What courses are Science electives?



There are 4 science subjects at WIT:

- Science (SCIN)
- Physics (PHYS)
- Chemistry (CHEM)
- Biology (BIOL)

Most of the courses in these subjects are accepted for science elective credit, but there are a few exceptions.

Common Science Elective options:

- BIOL1100
- BIOL1700
- BIOL2200
- BIOL3000
- CHEM1100
- CHEM1600
- PHYS1250
- PHYS1750
- PHYS2000
- PHYS3800

Science Courses that require special approval because they might satisfy the requirement:

BIOL2990, CHEM2990,
PHYS2990, BIOL3800,
CHEM3800 and PHYS3800

Tip- All Science electives need a lab component to be counted for credit
