Fall 2026 and Spring 2027 Housing Selection Process Guide

For: Continuing undergraduate students interested in living on campus during the Fall 2026 and Spring 2027 academic year. **This guide is not for Summer 2026. That is a separate process.**

Housing Selection FAQs:

General Campus Living

Who is eligible for on-campus housing?

- Unless otherwise noted, all students must be enrolled as an active, full-time Wentworth Institute of Technology student in classes or co-op to be eligible to live in Wentworth owned and/or operated residence halls.
 - A full-time academic course load for undergraduate students is twelve (12) semester credit hours.

Who is eligible to participate in housing selection?

- Current active Wentworth undergraduate students who will be continuing their undergraduate studies this Fall 2026 semester are eligible to participate.
 - **If you will be enrolling in a graduate program this Fall semester, please make your housing deposit with Graduate Admissions. You will then receive instructions regarding housing this summer. You do not go through this process as you will work with the Graduate Admissions office.**
 - **In order to participate in housing selection, you must submit your housing agreement by the 4:30 p.m. deadline on Friday, February 6 AND not have any holds on your Student E-Bill.**

Where will housing be offered?

- Residential communities that will be open for continuing students for the 2026-2027 Academic Year include:
 - 555 Huntington Avenue – Some rising sophomores, mainly juniors & seniors
 - 610 Huntington Avenue – All rising sophomores
 - 525 Huntington Avenue – Juniors & seniors only
 - 7 Vancouver Street – Juniors & seniors only
 - 9 Vancouver Street - Juniors & seniors only

- 15 Vancouver Street – Juniors & seniors only
- 60 Louis Prang - Juniors & seniors only
- 62 Louis Prang - Juniors & seniors only
- 66 Louis Prang – Juniors & seniors only
- University Operated Property – sophomores only

Are floor plans available for housing options?

- Yes, floor plans are available for students to view for insight into the building's layouts. While our office has tried our best to accurately display spaces, floor plans are only provided for general insight, and do not always accurately display layouts, furniture, or vacancies.

Do I need to live on campus?

- Per Wentworth's [residency requirement](#), all first-year and second-year students are required to live on campus. If you began studying at Wentworth this Fall 2025 or Spring 2026 semester as a first-year student, you are required to live on campus. Transfer students are encouraged to live on campus.

Finances and Billing

Is my housing down-payment refundable?

- By submitting your housing agreement and down payment, you are informing us of your intention to live on campus. Down payments are applied towards Fall 2026 housing bills and are **non-refundable/non-transferrable**. Students who submit a housing down payment but later elect not to live on campus for Fall 2026 forfeit the \$500 down-payment in accordance with the refund schedule noted on the housing agreement.

I have some financial difficulties and would like to request a waiver from the housing down payment.

- All students who qualify will already have access to the fee-waived agreement, as Financial Services shares a list of those who would qualify. Any student who anticipates having financial difficulty affording the housing down payment should submit a Housing Down Payment Waiver Request form on your [myHousing](#) portal by February 2, 2026.

What are the room and food plan fees for Fall 2026?

- Housing rates and food plan prices can be found [here](#). Housing rates are based on the final room occupancy rate selected during the housing assignment process. All residential students must select a food plan.

Fall 2026 student e-bills will be active in June. How will I be billed?

- Students will be billed through the [Student Accounts Office](#) in early June for the appropriate room and food plan amount, based on their selection during the housing selection process.

Housing Selection Participation

What will I need to do in order to participate in housing selection for Fall 2026?

- To select housing and live on campus in Fall 2026, students must:
 1. Submit a \$500 Fall 2026 housing down payment and housing agreement no later than February 6, 2026 4:30 p.m. EST using your [myHousing](#) portal (thd.wit.edu)
 - **Note:** If students submit a down payment after this deadline, they will be added to the late standby list. Housing assignment will be based on availability.
 2. Your Student Account must have a zero balance and no holds. If you have a hold, you will need to clear it before room selection before February 18.

When will housing selection occur?

- Fall 2026 Housing Selection is scheduled to occur the week of February 16th.
 - a. Selection will begin at 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, February 18.
 - b. Timeslots will be given based on the agreement date and admission term. We do not use credit hours.

When will I receive my individual selection time for housing selection?

- Students will receive an email notification of their selection date/time later in the week of February 9th.
 - Timeslots will be given based on the agreement date and admission term. We do not use credit hours.

How are selection times decided?

- Housing selection days/times are decided using the *myHousing* portal software system. Specific times for selection are determined based on the year you were admitted to Wentworth (how long you have been at Wentworth). Times do not correspond with how many credit hours you have and the day/time of your housing agreement.
 - As we have a two-year live-on requirement, all rising sophomores who are eligible for room selection will go through selection first. They will only be able

to see spaces in 610 Huntington, some of 555 Huntington, and all of our university-operated property located at Simmons University.

- Juniors and Seniors will select after the rising sophomores. They will be able to select in assignments in 555 Huntington, 525 Huntington, and Louis Prang-Vancouver.

Do I need a full roommate group to select Fall 2025/Spring 2026 housing?

- Full apartment/suite sizes on campus range anywhere from 3 to 9.
 - If you are in a **fully matched** roommate group, any of the students in the roommate group will be able to place themselves and group members into an open suite that matches the groups' size.
 - For example: If you are a group of 6 and a suite of 6 is open, you can place your group into that space.
 - You may need to split up your group if your desired configuration is not available. Make sure to have backup plans in place well before your turn to select! *See more information below.*
 - Students who submitted a down payment after the deadline cannot be added to the process, and therefore cannot be added to a student group. These students can be assigned housing after housing selection, pending availability.
 - *Roommate groups must be fully matched. This means each student in the group must request one another.*
 - *There is no "group leader" designated by the system, however, each group should decide which member is going to be the person to select an assignment for the group. We recommend the person with the earliest timeslot be the leader.*

What if I do not know who to live with?

- We highly recommend using the shared resources to find a roommate group you can select with.
 - **Roommate Matching Event: January 22, 7:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m. in Tudbury Auditorium for rising sophomores**
 - **Roommate Matching Event: January 22, 7:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m. in 610 Huntington lobby for juniors and seniors**
- Students who do not select a space with a group will be able to select a space that is vacant.
- If you do not participate in either the selection process or participate but do not finalize a housing assignment, Housing and Residential Education will manually assign you to a placement after the housing selection process has concluded, pending availability.

Can I change my roommate group?

- Yes, you can make any changes to your group between agreement opening and 4:30 p.m. on Friday, February 6. Be sure to be a fully matched roommate group, and that all members completed their housing agreement before the February 7, 4:30 pm deadline.

Which group sizes typically fit where?

- **Apartments@525 Rising Juniors & Seniors Only**
 - Mostly apartments of 4 students
 - Some apartments of 5 students
- **555 Huntington Avenue Some rising sophomores, mainly rising Juniors & Seniors**
 - Mostly suites of 6 students
 - Some suites of 8 students
 - Very few suites of 4, 5 and 9 students
- **610 Huntington Avenue Rising Sophomores Only**
 - Mostly suites of 6 students
 - Very few suites of 3, 4 and 5 students
- **15 Vancouver Street Rising Juniors & Seniors Only**
 - Primarily studio apartments (1-person apartments (available during non-group size restricted selection)
 - Few apartments of 2 students
- **9 Vancouver Street Rising Juniors & Seniors Only**
 - Mix of 2-person and 3-person apartments
- **7 Vancouver Street Rising Juniors & Seniors Only**
 - 4-person apartments
- **60, 62, 66, Louis Prang Street Rising Juniors & Seniors Only**
 - Mostly apartments of 2, 3 and 4 students

Note: Due to housing assignments for community advisors and/or students with approved accommodations, there may be a number of apartments available with less vacancies than the sizes noted above.

I am looking for other students to select housing with. How can I find other suitemates?

1. Use the profile finder tool on [myHousing](#) portal to browse other student profiles for those selecting fall housing
 - Log In
 - Click “Roommate and Room Selection”
 - Click “Select Roommate” and change the term to “**Fall 2026**”
 - Click “Search for Roommates”
2. Join us for our roommate mixer
3. Use social media

I will live on campus in Summer 2026. Can I remain in the same apartment for Fall 2026?

- We are unable to accommodate a process for rollover from the Summer to Fall semester.
 - If you'd like to attempt to remain in the same apartment as the summer into the fall, you may select it if it is available when you select housing.
- We are still determining summer buildings as we finalize summer projects. We should know which buildings once the summer agreement goes live on Wednesday, February 18.

I am going on co-op in the Fall 2026. What do I do?

- If you are anticipating a need for on-campus housing during your co-op experience, you should participate in housing selection.
- If your co-op experience will be outside of the Boston area, you may forego participating in housing selection.
 - If you plan to live on campus with us in the Spring 2027 semester, be sure to keep an eye on your WIT email. We'll communicate Spring 2027 housing information around October/November.

I am going on co-op in the Spring 2027. Should I go through this process?

- By participating in the Fall 2026/Spring 2027 housing selection process, the space you select will be yours for both the Fall 2026 and Spring 2027 semesters. If you need on-campus housing for this Fall, you should participate in this process. If you determine you no longer need housing for the spring semester due to a co-op opportunity outside of the Boston area, you may complete a housing and food plan cancellation form on the *myHousing* portal toward the end of the Fall semester.

Can residents of mixed genders reside in the same room?

- Yes, Wentworth offers mixed-gender housing.
 - Because students need to select in roommate groups that will fill the entire apartment/suite, students can form their groups with any students, regardless of their gender.
 - If you are interested in mixed-gender housing, be sure to select the appropriate selection on your housing agreement. This can be updated in your myHousing portal under My Information > My Info > For the term "Fall 2026"

- THIS IS IMPORTANT: You will need to use the "Mixed-Gender Suite" toggle filter on the room search screen to find available housing assignments that are mixed-gender. You must set the filter to "Yes".
 - If you want mixed-gender housing, set the filter to YES
 - If you do NOT want mixed-gender housing, set the filter to NO

Dates to keep in mind

What are the dates of the Fall 2026 semester?

- Once the academic calendar is updated, you can find it [here](#). **Students on co-op should keep these dates in mind when determining their co-op start and end date. Please plan all winter break travel, co-op dates, etc. based on the academic calendar.**

When do I move-in for Fall 2026?

- Students will receive their assigned move-in date and time early in August.

Woah, lots of dates and times. Can I have a recap?

- **February 6 by 4:30 p.m.:** Housing Down Payment and Agreement due, as well as roommate/suitemate matching
- **Week of February 9:** Housing selection dates/times sent via WIT email
 - Once selection times are sent, students will be able to see available spaces.
- **February 18 – February 20:** Housing selection occurs

Housing Selection Process Detailed Instructions

Step 1: Submitting a Housing Down Payment

Due February 6 by 4:30 pm EST to participate in housing selection processes

Housing down payments for Fall 2026 housing are being accepted until Friday, February 6, 2026, by 4:30 p.m. This \$500 down payment is applied towards your Fall 2026 housing bill.

Housing down payments are submitted during the completion of the housing agreement on your [myHousing](#) portal.

Any student who anticipates having financial difficulty affording the housing down-payment should submit a Housing Down Payment Waiver Request form on your [myHousing](#) portal, by February 2, 2026.

Students must submit their down payment prior to 4:30 p.m. on Friday, February 6 to participate in housing selection processes. Also, you must clear any holds on your E-Bill before room selection.

Step 2: Housing Selection Processes

(only available to those eligible)



Housing Selection

- Full apartment/suite sizes on campus range anywhere from 3 to 9.
 - If you are in a **fully matched** roommate group, any of the students in the roommate group will be able to place themselves and group members into an open suite that matches the groups' size.
 - For example: If you are a group of 6 and a suite of 6 is open, you can place your group into that space.
 - You may need to split up your group if your desired configuration is not available. Make sure to have backup plans in place well before your turn to select! *See more information below.*
 - Students who submitted a down payment after the deadline cannot be added to the process, and therefore cannot be added to a student group. These students can be assigned housing after housing selection, pending availability.

Where Does My Selection Time Fall in the Group-Size Restricted Process?

- Housing selection days/times are decided using the *myHousing* portal software system. Specific times for selection are determined based on the year you were admitted to Wentworth (how long you have been at Wentworth). Times do not correspond with how many credit hours you have and the day/time of your housing agreement.
 - As we have a two-year live-on requirement, all rising sophomores who are eligible for room selection will go through selection first. They will only be able to see spaces in 610 Huntington, some of 555 Huntington, and all of our university-operated property located at Simmons University.
 - Juniors and Seniors will select after the rising sophomores. They will be able to select in assignments in 555 Huntington, 525 Huntington, and Louis Prang-Vancouver.

For All Students:

1. From January 27th until your selection time, familiarize yourself with the housing selection system, [myHousing](#) portal. Students may log in, update their “My Info” and Emergency Contact information, as well as see available spaces that will be online for selection.
 - To see available spaces to determine your housing selection plans:
 - Navigate to [myHousing](#) portal.
 - Click “Roommate and Room Selection” on left menu pane
 - Click” Select a Room/Suite” on left menu pane
 - This screen will show:
 - Any important messages
 - Your roommate group (if applicable)
 - List of all rooms, with a data filtering option

 - You may need to split up your group if your desired configuration is not available. Make sure to have backup plans in place well before your turn to select!
- To form a group, please follow the instructions below:
 - Log into [myHousing](#) portal
 - On the left pane, select “Roommate and Room Selection”
 - Click “Select Roommates”
 - Change term to “Fall 2026”
 - Click “Search for Roommate” and use the profile filter tools
 - To show all available roommate profiles, leave all filters blank, and select “Begin Search”
 - Note: If you prefer to not have your roommate profile visible, you may change this setting under “My Information” > “Roommate Profile”*
 - Once you find the roommate you want to send a request to, click “Request Roommate”
