VA Benefits Process

1. Apply through the VA
 - a. Go to va.gov/education/how-to-apply
 - b. Skip this step if you have received your Certificate of Eligibility (COE)
 - c. Chapter 31 VR & E do not receive a COE.
2. Register for classes
 - a. VA educational benefits will be certified after you are registered for any given semester
3. Complete the Military Benefits Form
 - a. Complete the form thirty (30) days before the first day of each semester you are registered if you want to utilize your benefits
 - b. The form must be completed before each semester's due dates of **August 1, December 1, and April 1**
 - c. The form is located on the Military-Connected Services webpage
 - d. The submittal of this form indicates to the Student Accounts Office who gains access to the Military Connected Student Lounge space each semester
4. Wentworth certifies your benefits with the VA
 - a. Typically occurs thirty (30) days before the start of the semester
 - b. The Student Accounts Office requests VA benefits to cover tuition and fees for Chapter 31 and Chapter 33 students after the add/drop period each semester
5. Stipends and MHA (BAH) benefits paid by the VA
 - a. Paid monthly directly to the student during the certified semester
 - b. It starts on the first of the month after the semester starts
 - c. Amounts are prorated for partial months, part-time, and online students
6. Report changes
 - a. Report any changes to your class schedule or major within forty-eight (48) hours by completing the Veteran Benefit Certification Schedule Change Form
 - b. This Form is located on the Military-Connected Services webpage
