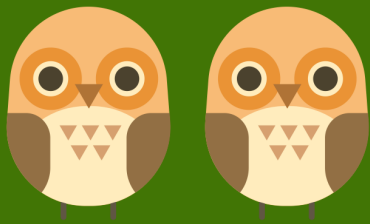


# APA format

How to cite sources



## 1 in-text citation

After using information you got from a source in your paper, include the author's name and the date of publication in parentheses.

**EXAMPLE:**

The author explains, "Chloe liked Olivia" (Woolf 1929).

## 2 references page

On the last page of your paper, list all sources alphabetically according to the authors' last names.

**EXAMPLE:**

Woolf, V. (1929). *A Room of One's Own*. London: Hogarth Press.



Always label your images and graphs so they make sense!

## tables, graphs, and images

---

If you use an image or graph from a source in your paper, make a caption for it directly below the image or graph. Include citation information such as author and date in the caption.

The captions should be numbered throughout your paper, starting with "figure 1."

Cite the source where you got the image or graph in your references page.
