Privacy Statement

This Privacy Policy discloses the privacy practices for WIT.edu and for all subdomains of WIT.edu, and for content using other electronic media hosted or generated by Wentworth Institute of Technology, subject to the individual privacy practices of third-parties whose services Wentworth Institute of Technology may be using.

What information do we gather about you?

We collect information from you when you access WIT.edu and when you subscribe to our email service. Specifically, by placing a cookie in the visitor's browser, Wentworth's website captures visitor data in three primary areas:

1. Situational (date/time, device, location, etc.)
2. Behavioral (origin URL, page views, time on page, clicks, downloads, etc.)
3. Personally identifiable (name, email, phone, company, title, etc.)

What do we use your information for?

We use your IP address to help diagnose problems with our server and to administer our website by identifying (1) which parts of our site are most heavily used, and (2) which portion of our audience comes from within the WIT network. We receive and may store any information you enter on our website or give us in any other way. We may use this information to personalize your experience with WIT.edu. You can choose not to provide certain information, but then you might not be able to take advantage of many of our features. (You may opt out by disabling the cookies in your web browser.)The email address you provide may be used to send you information, respond to inquiries, and/or other requests or questions. (You may opt out of future emails through a link in the email.)

User information may be shared with third-party partners to the extent necessary to provide and improve web services or other communications to users. Any third parties who receive user information for this purpose are prohibited from using or sharing user information for any purpose other than providing services to users.

We may also provide your information to third parties in circumstances where we believe that doing so is necessary or appropriate to: satisfy any applicable law, regulation, legal process or governmental request; detect, prevent or otherwise address fraud, security or technical issues; or protect the rights, property or safety of us, our users or others.

Device Information Collected By Us

We may collect information about the computer, mobile device or other device you use to access WIT.edu, such as IP address, geolocation information, unique device identifiers, browser type, browser language or other information of this nature. We use this information in an aggregate fashion to track access to WIT.edu. We do not disclose site usage by individual IP addresses. Web server logs are retained on a temporary basis and then deleted from our systems.

Cookies

Cookies are small files that are stored on your computer (unless you block them). We use cookies to understand and save your preferences for future visits and compile aggregate data about site traffic and site interaction so that we can offer better site experiences and tools in the future. We may contract with third-party service providers to assist us in better understanding our site visitors. These service providers are not permitted to use the information collected on our behalf except to help us conduct and improve our business.

Third-Party Cookies

Cookies may be set by an organization other than WIT.edu. These “third-party cookies” may, for example, originate from websites such as YouTube, Twitter, Facebook, Google Plus or other social media services for which WIT.edu has implemented “plug-ins.” Since the cookie policies of these sites change over time, you should determine their policies by visiting the privacy policy pages of these sites directly.

Wentworth may use Google services to deliver and monitor our advertising campaigns which may, in turn, use cookies to help us serve and manage ads across the internet. We may also use the information gained to serve you ads based on your previous interactions on our website.
