Ever changing, Wentworth continues to offer a valuable education that is deeply rooted in our core founding principles of honesty, energy, economy, and system.

Adjusting to Today's Engineering Revolution

THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN ENGINEERING AND ENGINEERING TECHNOLOGY CAN BE A BIT CONFUSING. THE LINE THAT SEPARATES THE TWO IS BLURRED DUE IN PART TO THE INCREASINGLY TIGHT COLLABORATION BETWEEN THE DISCIPLINES.

Sandeep Dilwali, associate department head, electronics and mechanical, explained the importance of both disciplines: "Whenever you travel to work and pass over a bridge, drive through a tunnel, or run with an iPod on a treadmill, you are experiencing the collaboration between engineers and technologists. Each side brings distinct skills and training essential to moving a project from conception to completion. Each works in different capacities throughout the process, yet both have the same objective: to create innovative solutions that work. Without engineering technology, the application of a concept, design, or prototype, which is often created by an engineer, may not result in an integrated, functional end product." (*Prism Magazine*, Summer 2008)

Engineering technology programs have long been the backbone of a Wentworth education. Many alumni who graduate from these programs establish rewarding careers in the engineering field

as technologists; others continue on in their studies and earn licensure in their chosen discipline.

Over the last year, Wentworth has begun in earnest to determine where its next level of growth should be. Knowing that the need for engineers continues to grow, the Institute is examining the merits of introducing a new engineering-specific professional program in mechanical, civil, or electrical engineering. As with all new programs, decisions about how to best proceed will be made based on how each would serve the needs of students and industry, and on trends and professional industry association recommendations.

Wentworth remains committed to making sure its graduates are prepared for as wide a range of job opportunities as possible. In addition to supporting the economic growth of Massachusetts, the Institute will more effectively position graduates to have increased positive influences nationwide due to state-by-state professional engineering licensure rules.

TRANSITIONING TOOLS AND INNOVATIVE INSTRUMENTS

Wentworth to Introduce a Biomedical Engineering Program

TO MEET THE DEMANDS OF THE RAPIDLY GROWING FIELD OF BIOMEDICAL ENGINEERING AND TO PROVIDE INCREASED EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES FOR STUDENTS, WENTWORTH WILL LAUNCH A NEW FOUR-YEAR BIOMEDICAL ENGINEERING PROGRAM IN FALL 2011. THE LAUNCH WILL BE GUIDED BY PROGRAM DIRECTOR DR. SHANKAR KRISHNAN, A FACULTY MEMBER IN THE DEPARTMENT OF ELECTRONICS AND MECHANICAL.

A Biomedical Engineering program, while certainly an exciting new initiative, is not a radical addition to the academic majors Wentworth offers. Students in the Electromechanical Engineering program who have chosen the concentration of Biomedical Systems Engineering have already undertaken projects that are closely aligned to this new program. A wheelchair with sensors to help doctors assess treatment, a sub-atmospheric chamber to improve blood flow, and an operating table that enables vertical positioning for treating patients are examples of student work and projects. The Biomedical Engineering program will allow students to expand these efforts in a focused environment.

The program will leverage existing technical expertise for designing and building instrumentation and creating devices that provide critical solutions at the intersection of biology and medicine. As Boston is home to some of the nation's leading medical institutions and biomedical employers, students will have access to valuable co-op opportunities that will give them a competitive advantage when they enter the workforce.

Enrollment for the inaugural class will be limited to 24 students, and by the fifth year of the program, is expected to increase to 50. Both students in the new program and students in the Biomedical Systems Engineering concentration will enjoy new resources such as courses, laboratories, and projects. Once the proposed laboratories are functional, they will also be used for all student projects that involve biomedical applications, including Mechanical Engineering Technology and Electronic Engineering Technology, thus increasing opportunities for student learning and the return on investment.

Master's Programs

Starting as a trade school in 1904, offering associate degrees beginning in 1956, and adding four-year baccalaureate degrees in 1970, Wentworth has succeeded by building on its original foundation. The Institute has now reached another major academic milestone: accreditation to grant master's degrees.

Graduate-level programs are a logical progression. They ensure that Wentworth will continue to provide advanced educational opportunities that give students the knowledge and skills they need to position themselves for successful and rewarding careers. This important transition to offering advanced degrees reflects the Institute's history of carefully managed growth. It also highlights the importance of close collaboration with industry to ensure that their demands and student and workforce needs are met.

The Master of Architecture (MArch) program is the first master's-level degree that the Institute will confer. Building on Wentworth's experiential education model, the program will offer students a quicker path to licensure, a greater focus on research skills for sophisticated problem solving, and more in-depth knowledge and training from top-tier faculty educated at the world's most prestigious architecture and design institutions. The MArch program "extends the department's tradition of educating outstanding architect interns," says Department Head Glenn Wiggins, who spearheaded the accreditation process.

The architecture program at Wentworth is structured as a ten-semester, four-year pre-professional degree (Bachelor of Science in Architecture) followed by a two-semester, one-year professional degree (MARCH) for continuing students. The one-year graduate-level program provides the basis for awarding the MArch degree and represents an accelerated path for students seeking an advanced degree. Portfolios of applicants with a four-year degree in architecture from another university are carefully reviewed, and a two-year residency is expected.

Adult Education

The Arioich Center @ Wentworth, previously known as the Division of Professional and Continuing Studies (DPCS), is redefining its adult education programs and the learning styles in which they are taught. As today's adult learner requires more flexibility to balance work, life, and study, The Arioich Center is looking at offering degree and certificate programs through an innovative hybrid model that combines online, weekend, and classroom elements. The Institute expects to expand The Arioich Center's functionality and academic offerings in 2010.

New Institute Classification

The Carnegie Foundation for the Advancement of Teaching selected Wentworth for the classification "Community Engagement" under the section "Curricular Engagement & Outreach and Partnerships." This new category, created in 2006, recognizes the importance of community engagement in higher education. Of the 119 institutions selected in 2008 for the elective "Community Engagement" classification, Wentworth is the only one with a specialized focus on technology and is one of only 11 colleges and universities selected from Massachusetts. The classification represents Wentworth's commitment to service learning and civic engagement, as well as the breadth of the Institute's relationships with the community.



Congressional Grant Awarded to Institute

Associate Professor Ali Khabari

The U.S. Department of Education awarded the Institute a congressionally directed grant for \$190,000. The grant was submitted by Associate Professor Ali Khabari and Interim Department Head Frederick Driscoll from the Department of Electronics and Mechanical, and the Provost's Office. This grant, combined with three previously received grants, was used to build a nanoparticle deposition system designed by Khabari.

The machine makes nanoparticles, which faculty and students use to make nanostructured films. The films'

unique optical properties are studied and analyzed, as each has different mechanical and electrical properties. "The excitement is the unique properties," says Khabari. "We are basically making new materials that do not exist in nature. By finding new materials, we are giving a third dimension to the periodic table. We are hoping to make devices such as sensors using nanoparticles."

"Industry, government, academia, and researchers worldwide believe that major breakthroughs and new developments are achieved at the

intersections of academic disciplines where multiple fields meet," says Dr. Russell Pinizzotto, vice president for academic affairs and provost. Wentworth uses resources in as many ways as possible, leveraging both equipment and space across disciplines. With this in mind, besides being used to teach increasingly popular nanotechnology courses, the new resources will also be used for senior design nanotechnology projects, independent faculty and student projects, and biomedical engineering research when the program launches in Fall 2011.

ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENTS

Dr. Russell Pinizzotto was appointed vice president for academic affairs and provost in February 2009. With over 22 years of experience in academia as an administrator, educator, and innovator, Dr. Pinizzotto is responsible for all academic affairs related to undergraduate, graduate, and continuing education programs. He will also lead efforts to enhance the excellence of existing, nationally-recognized undergraduate programs and guide the development of new degree offerings.

The provost is joining a talented group of faculty members who this past year have participated in industry conferences and publications, developed new programs, and been recognized for their outstanding achievements. The following is a sampling of faculty and student highlights across academic departments:

Department of Architecture

Government officials and design leaders from Venezuela and Colombia visited campus to speak about their achievements in urban redevelopment as part of an event titled *Design for Life*. The event, organized by **ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR ROBERT COWHERD** and **ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR MANUEL DELGADO**, included a panel discussion, an exhibition, and a photographic display showcasing examples of redevelopment. The keynote speaker was Sergio Fajardo Valderrama, former mayor of Medellin, Colombia, and a candidate for president of Colombia in 2010.

ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR CAROL BURNS was elected to the College of Fellows, one of the highest honors the American Institute of Architects (AIA) bestows.

ASSISTANT PROFESSOR INGRID STRONG, in collaboration with Maryann Thompson Architects in Cambridge, received a K-12 Educational Facilities Award for The Children's School, a Montessori-based school in Stamford, Conn. The award, which was started by the Boston Society of Architects and co-sponsored by the AIA NY chapter, honors design that supports teaching and learning.

Department of Design and Facilities

The International Interior Design Association (IIDA) recognized two interior design students at an awards ceremony for the association's New England chapter. **MEGAN DOBSTAFF, BINT '10**, won

the 2009 Best Undergraduate Award and **OLENA IVANINA, BINT '09**, received an honorable mention.

ASSISTANT PROFESSOR NILGUN TURAN presented a paper titled *Concept in Design* at the Savannah College of Art and Design MUSE Conference.

DEPARTMENT HEAD SUZANNE KENNEDY co-presented a paper titled *Exploring Emerging Measures Since 9/11* at the International Facilities Management Association (IFMA) World Workplace Conference.

Under the direction of **ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR SAM MONTAGUE** and **PROFESSOR FREDERICK KUHN, JOEL TETREAU, BIND '00**, facilitated a Calphalon-sponsored junior industrial design studio project. At the conclusion of the project, representatives from the kitchenware manufacturer visited Wentworth to review the student-created design solutions.

Department of Computer Science and Systems

ASSISTANT PROFESSOR LEONIDAS DELIGIANNIDIS, PROFESSOR MICHAEL WERNER, and **ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR JOHN RUSSO** submitted a paper titled *Google Earth as a Decision Support System for Targeting College Admissions Drives* to the 2008 International Conference on Frontiers in Education: Computer Science and Computer Engineering. The paper uses admissions data to plot on Google Earth where Wentworth students are from, information that helps target recruitment efforts.

The Distinguished Service and Educational Award was given to Deligiannidis at the WORLD-COMP '08 conference. Deligiannidis also received the Best Paper Award at the HSI '09 conference for his paper titled *Visual and Proprioceptive Integration of the Virtual and Real Fingertips*.

Department of Electronics and Mechanical

ASSISTANT PROFESSORS DOUGLAS DOW and **ILIE TALPASANU** worked with four electromechanical engineering students—**DAVID ARRUDA**, **WILLIAM WILSON**, **CRYSTAL NGUYEN**, and **QI YAO**—to design a proteomics sensor during their yearlong senior project. The students collaborated with Dr. Brian Liu of Brigham and Women's Hospital and wrote a review journal article based on their design. Titled *Microelectrical Sensors for Protein Biomarker Detection in Point-of-Care Diagnostics*, it was published in *Expert Reviews*.

PROFESSOR MANSOUR ZENOUI was recognized by the American Society of Mechanical Engineers (ASME) in appreciation of his dedicated service as technical program chair of the 2009 Energy Sustainability Conference.

Department of Applied Mathematics and Science

ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR AND DEPARTMENT HEAD STEPHEN NODVIN served on the editorial advisory board and was a topic editor for the *Encyclopedia of Earth*, an electronic reference about the Earth, its natural environments, and their interaction with society. Nodvin authored articles on watershed, global warming, radiative forcing, and the national climate data center.

PROFESSOR GARY SIMUNDZA presented a paper, *Contextual Activities to Drive Basic Mathematics*, at a conference for the National Association for Developmental Education. Simundza also presented

a paper at the American Mathematical Association of Two-Year Colleges Conference titled *A Modeling-Based College Algebra Course for Technical Students*.

Department of Civil, Construction, and Environment

ASSISTANT PROFESSOR JAMES LAMBRECHTS was appointed to the American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE) Paraprofessional Task Committee. The mission of the committee is to help the society recognize and support paraprofessionals within the civil engineering profession. Lambrechts was also appointed to chair the editorial board of the journal *Civil Engineering Practice* of the Boston Society of Civil Engineers (BCSE) section of ASCE.

PROFESSOR MARK HASSO was appointed to the Construction Management Association of America foundation board. Hasso also received the Civil Engineer of the Year award from the BSCE's section of the ASCE.

Department of Humanities, Social Sciences, and Management

ASSISTANT PROFESSOR GLORIA MONAGHAN chaired the summer reading program, which resulted in a campus visit by Frederick Reiken, author of *The Odd Sea*.

ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR CINDY STEVENS presented research to over 75 company representatives, explaining the value of electronic portfolios (EP). Her presentation titled *The ePortfolio: Educating the Whole Student: What's our Evidence* was part of the Northeast Regional Computing Program. Along with Stevens, **MICHAEL BURKE, BSM '09**, presented his EP, which he developed while a student at the Institute.

First Year Seminar Helps Freshmen Thrive

For incoming freshmen, attending college is a significant milestone. Colleges and universities face the challenge of preparing these newest members of their community to be successful. In Fall 2008, Wentworth embarked on a new retention initiative called the First Year Seminar (FYS), which covers a variety of academic skills and explores common transitional issues.

The seminar, which has been incorporated into the curriculum and meets weekly for 50 minutes during students' first semester, applies a variety of pedagogical approaches to create an interactive, learning-centered classroom. FYS instructors, who also serve as advisors, come from a wide range of academic and non-academic departments. Students learn about campus resources, receive academic guidance, and have the opportunity to work through developmental issues. They also have a unique chance to make a strong connection with a faculty or staff member.

The seminar was an immediate success for first-year students and the Institute. During the program's inaugural year, appointments made at the Center for Teaching and Learning increased by 20 percent. These numbers can be attributed to efforts stemming from FYS, including the support of instructors, referrals to the Center for Teaching and Learning, and teaching academic skills and strategies necessary for success at Wentworth.

Joan Giblin, director of New Student Programs, planned and implemented FYS. "I think the best thing about FYS is that the faculty and staff that teach the course are specially trained to focus on communicating with the students and fostering a strong bond," says Giblin. "The instructors are the voice that reinforces the mission of the Institute."

When Maureen Dischino, director of admissions, discovered that both faculty and staff had the opportunity to teach a seminar, she applied immediately. Being an FYS instructor allowed Dischino to build closer relationships with students than ever before, and to learn from them. Even outside the classroom, Dischino was visited by students seeking her opinion or advice. "The content covered in FYS helps ease students' transition from high school to college and provides them with a better chance of academic

success,” says Dischino. “The students gave each other tips on how to overcome challenges, which in turn helped me to learn things that I can now pass on to other students.”

Robert Da Silva, BCET '12, was a student in Dischino's seminar and shares her enthusiasm for the program. One of the biggest benefits for him was the unique perspective Dischino offered on writing. “Maureen was able to teach us how to effectively capture another person's interest from her experience hand-selecting incoming students to Wentworth after reading admission essays,” says Da Silva.

How Students Are Impacting Our Community

Wentworth's proximity to Mission Hill and involvement with the community play an important role in defining both the Institute and its students. “We connect faculty, staff, and students to the community to do two fundamental things: to learn and to make a difference,” says Sean Bender, director, Center for Community & Learning Partnerships (CLP).

The amount of time and energy Wentworth students dedicate to community-based projects inspired the Institute to establish a Certificate in Community Learning. To earn the certificate, students follow a comprehensive program that formally integrates service learning into the educational experience. The certificate was first awarded at the August 2008 Commencement Convocation, and 13 graduating students have since earned the distinction.

Kera Murphy, BSM '09, began her time at Wentworth just as many other students have—with Service Day. Held the first weekend freshmen arrive on campus as part of Wentworth Opening

Week, Service Day introduces new students to Wentworth's commitment to the local community. After spending the day painting fences in Mission Hill, Murphy never could have predicted how much community involvement would be integrated into her experience at Wentworth.

The experience that began with Service Day grew into her co-op position as public relations coordinator for the CLP, working to establish and build relationships between the Institute, its students, and the Mission Hill community. Her interest in outreach and giving back also took her on a service trip to New Orleans through the CLP during spring break of her senior year. When Murphy received the Certificate in Community Learning as a result of time spent on community projects, she felt very grateful. “I was honored to be presented with this recognition, and I hold it in very high regard,” she says.

Wentworth Implements New Recruitment Techniques

Student recruitment requires a high level of energy and enthusiasm, and the Office of Admissions has kept up-to-date with new strategies for connecting with high school students. By reevaluating recruitment techniques and utilizing social media, increased travel, and specialized diversity outreach, Wentworth has been more successful than ever in reaching prospective students. In the last year, admissions established a Facebook fan page and a Twitter account, enhanced the current student blogs to showcase the Wentworth experience, participated in online chats with potential students, and held virtual college fairs. While the social media efforts are of vast importance, these efforts are not the only way in which Wentworth has refined its recruiting style to reach its growing and diverse prospective student population.

For over a decade, the Women's Overnight program has been an effective tool for demonstrating the accomplishments of Wentworth's female students, and the opportunities open to them. This past spring, Wentworth held two overnight visits to

accommodate increasing female student interest. The event was a success once again, as 55 of the attendees made their final decision to come to Wentworth.

Historically, the majority of women enrolled at Wentworth have received degrees in the design programs. In an effort to generate increased interest in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (STEM) programs, an informational event for female high school sophomore and junior students was organized. Attendees learned about STEM majors offered on campus and heard words of wisdom from keynote speaker Thea Sahr, associate director of educational outreach at the WGBH Educational Foundation.

Admissions teamed up with student organizations like the National Society of Black Engineers (NSBE), the Society of Hispanic Professional Engineers (SHPE), and the Multicultural Student Association (MSA) to showcase the diverse clubs on campus for prospective students, and also to assist the clubs in recruiting more participants. NSBE, SHPE, and MSA conducted phonathons, calling prospective students to congratulate them on their

acceptance. SHPE also sent letters to all accepted Hispanic students, reaching out to them as a resource and encouraging them to become involved in the club if they chose to attend the Institute.

To advance Wentworth's reputation for supporting diversity, efforts have been focused on expanding recruitment both nationally and internationally. Admissions counselors' recruitment

trips now include California, Texas, Florida, the Dominican Republic, United Arab Emirates, India, Nepal, and China. The result can be seen in the rising number of international students at Wentworth.

Involvement Beyond the Classroom

Dr. H. Russell Beatty, president of Wentworth from 1953–1971, believed his students should be well-rounded and involved. To achieve this, he introduced the policy of mandatory enrichment, where students were required to spend an hour a day participating in an activity of their choice. While this is no longer a requirement at the Institute, being involved is still an integral part of the Wentworth experience.

The Office of Student Leadership Programs (SLP) facilitates educational, social, cultural, and recreational experiences. SLP allows students to explore leadership, teamwork, and knowledge of the world beyond the classroom through more than 30 official student clubs. The wide range of offerings

includes Student Government, Wentworth Table Tennis, The Green Team, numerous club sports teams, and the Multicultural Student Association.

During the 2008–2009 academic year over 200 students participated in *Soar in Four*, a four-year program that helps students improve leadership skills and develop a personal leadership style. The program explores leadership theories while focusing on the four values of the SLP's leadership commitment: active engagement, open-mindedness, awareness, and collaboration.

The SLP has also established the Professional Development Grant Fund for Students, which allows students or student groups to participate in professional development activities related to one of four areas: career exploration, leadership development, service to the community, or promotion of social justice. In the 2008–2009 academic year, grants valued at more than \$32,000 were awarded for professional development to 9 student groups and 11 individuals.

How Alumni Are Staying Connected and Giving Back to the Institute

THE OFFICE OF INSTITUTIONAL ADVANCEMENT IS DEDICATED TO STRENGTHENING THE WENTWORTH COMMUNITY BY CONNECTING WITH ALUMNI, DONORS, CORPORATIONS, AND OTHER EXTERNAL AUDIENCES WITH LINKS TO WENTWORTH.



Over the past year, several initiatives were implemented to provide exciting new opportunities for developing and sustaining mutually beneficial relationships, including a new mentoring program, an online community, a redesigned alumni magazine, an enhanced phonathon program, and updated alumni events.

To further connect with alumni, facilitate networking, and easily share information about events, the Office of Alumni Relations (OAR) launched WITnet, an online community, in April 2009. Initially released as a trial launch to a select group of alumni, the online community was an instant success, with a large number of alumni joining and taking advantage of its features. WITnet provides access to a permanent Wentworth e-mail forwarding address, online class notes and photo submissions, and event registration. Since its launch, WITnet has been used by 90 percent of alumni who registered for events.

In the last year, the OAR increased the number of events offered, and alumni responded by increasing their attendance. In addition, alumni regional chapters have recently been established in San Francisco, Arizona, Atlanta, New York City, Rhode Island, and Seattle.

As a way to engage alumni with current students, Wentworth established the *Dinner with 8 Strangers* program. This mentoring program provides four students and four alumni the opportunity to come together

For students, the program has been a fun and valuable networking experience that exceeded their expectations, while for alumni, it has been a welcome opportunity to interact with

Through the Annual Fund and Senior Class Gift, Wentworth is teaching students about the benefits and responsibilities of philanthropy before they graduate. This year over \$6,200 was raised from 146 donors, including seniors and their parents, with proceeds going to a fund for future environmental projects on campus.

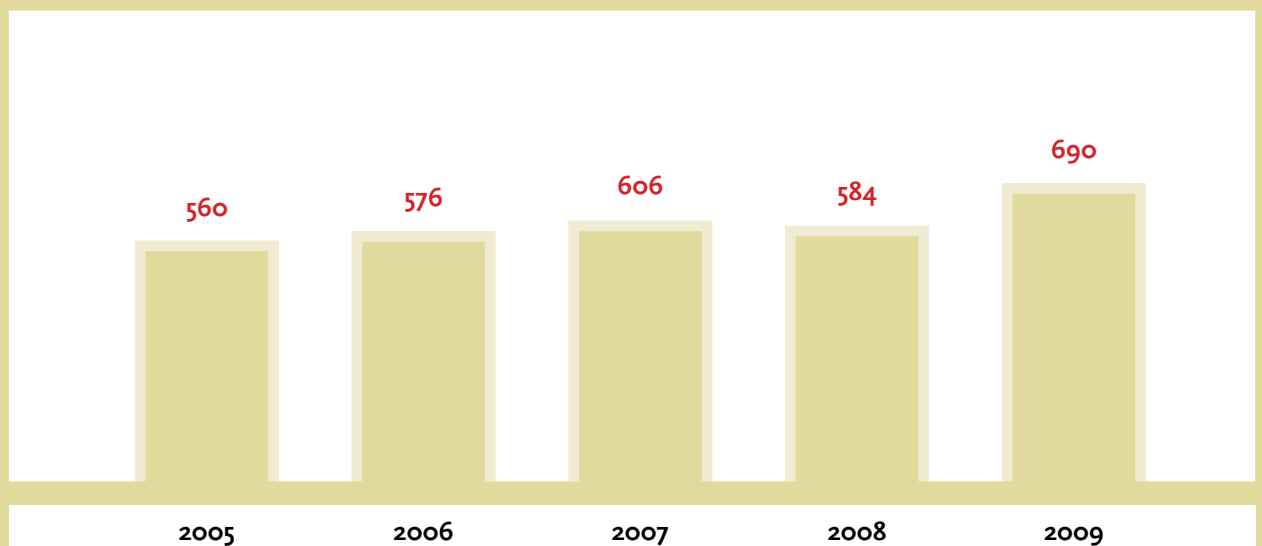
